

RULE 10 - RECEIVERS

10.1 A Motion for the Appointment of a Receiver in any proceeding, pursuant to Chapter 2735 or Section 1313.56 of the Ohio Revised Code, shall be submitted to the Judge to whom the case has been assigned or if such Motion is filed contemporaneously with a Complaint, to the Judge designated by the Administrative Judge of this Court. Notice of the date and time of the Hearing thereon shall be served upon all parties, excluding the moving party, or their counsel and no such motion shall be heard Ex Parte unless it clearly appears from Affidavits filed with the Motion that extraordinary hardship, loss, or prejudice would result to the moving party by any delay in the proceeding. Notwithstanding the issuance of an Ex Parte Order as provided herein, a Hearing on the continuance of such Order shall be scheduled at the earliest possible time by the Court in the same Entry Appointing the Receiver. Evidence upon any such Hearing may be in the form of Affidavits or Depositions which must be filed prior to the Hearing. The Court shall determine if additional evidence, including oral testimony, shall be permitted at the Hearing.
